INSTRUCTIONS

Scholarship recipients from the Fall 2017 - Spring 2018 academic year may, at their option, complete only this application and provide their most recent *official* grade transcript along with a certification from the educational institution that the applicant remains in good academic standing with no disciplinary actions brought against them.

Scholarships do not automatically renew each year, and receiving an award in one year does not guarantee you awards in future years. Therefore, prior year recipients may find it in their interest to complete the full length application in subsequent years to fully display their achievements. If you were awarded a scholarship in a previous year but *not* in 2017-2018, you must compete the full-length application.

- Read all instructions and follow all directions completely. *Incomplete applications will not be considered.*
- Applications must be typed or printed clearly and must be completed by the applicant.
- Include a sealed *official* transcript of your most recent grades. Unofficial grade transcripts (including self-generated computer grade printouts or class schedules) will not be accepted as a substitute for the official grade transcript from the registrar's office of the educational institution.
- Do not print 2 sided copies or use staples on any pages.
- Do not include this instruction page with your application submission.
- Retain a copy of the completed application for your records.

AWARD CRITERIA

Awards will primarily be based on academic achievement and potential, personal achievement, and community involvement. Scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, color, religion, sex or national origin. Applications will be judged by an independent and impartial Selection Committee, comprised of distinguished members of the community. Financial need may also be considered in making awards. The Selection Committee may request information concerning the financial circumstances of applicants and use this information in the award of scholarships.

In addition, six scholarships will be given to six "Second Chance" applicants. Those selected will be students whose academic achievement is not the best in their region, but rather students who demonstrate that they want another chance at an education that will help them get a good paying job.

Awards will be announced in August 2018, and may be found through the Members section at www.ua.org. All applicants will be notified by mail of final results.
